3. Hazards identification

Poisons Schedule: None allocated.

4. First-aid measures

Inhalation: Remove victim from area of exposure - avoid becoming a casualty. Seek medical advice if effects persist.

Eye Contact: If in eyes, wash out immediately with water. In all cases of eye contamination it is a sensible precaution to seek medical advice.

5. Fire-fighting measures

Specific Hazards: Non-combustible material.

Fire-fighting advice: Not combustible, however following evaporation of the water component of the material, the residual material can burn if ignited. On burning will emit toxic fumes. Fire fighters to wear self-contained breathing apparatus and suitable protective clothing if risk of exposure to vapour or products of combustion.

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Water fog (or if unavailable fine water spray), foam, dry agent (carbon dioxide, dry chemical powder).

6. Accidental release measures

SMALL SPILLS: Slippery when spilt. Avoid accidents, clean up immediately. Wipe up with rag or absorbent paper.

LARGE SPILLS: Slippery when spilt. Avoid accidents, clean up immediately. Wear protective equipment to prevent skin and eye contact. Contain - prevent run off into drains and waterways. Use absorbent (soil, sand or other inert material). Collect and seal in properly labelled containers or drums for disposal. Wash area down with excess water. Cured material can only be removed by cutting or abrasion.

7. Handling and storage

Handling advice: Avoid eye contact and repeated or prolonged skin contact.

Storage advice: Store in cool place and out of direct sunlight. Store away from incompatible materials described in Section 10. Protect from freezing. Keep containers closed when not in use - check regularly for leaks.
